Phase 2 of grant applications open through October 1

Evergy will award grants totaling \$800,000 in two phases, ranging from \$5,000 to \$25,000. As part of this effort, Evergy also invested in two small business loan funds, Network Kansas and the GKC COVID Small Business Relief Fund.
